Application guidelines





We want this funding application process to be as accessible as possible and not just limited to online or paper submissions. We welcome applications from a range of young people in any format, all we ask is that it answers the questions we ask in our application form. You can apply online, by video, a drawing, writing – whatever works best for you! All applications received will meet the same degree of acceptance, traditional application methods will not be favoured.

The Declaration and Final Consent section are the only parts that need to be signed and agreed upon.



Section 1 – About You:

Question 1 – Sponsor details:

You need to have a sponsor to hold the award money, and they need to provide all their details when submitting your application. We will be contacting them to confirm that they will be holding the award in their accounts and that they will supply receipts or a financial breakdown of the spending if you are successful. If you cannot find a sponsor, ES will act as your sponsor, only to hold the funding for you. Unfortunately at this time, we cannot offer more support than this.

Question 2 – Grant application details:

Please provide all your up-to-date contact details, as we will also wish to contact you and meet with you and your sponsor to discuss the award and your application.

Section 2 – Your Grant Application:

Part A – Application Details

Question 1:

Here we want to know how much of the funding you are asking for.

Question 2:

Here we are looking for a brief outline of your project and how the funding would benefit your project.

Question 3:

Here we are looking to ensure we can provide you with the funding when you are requesting it. There are clear deadlines for each award so please ensure that the project begins after the decision date.



Section 2 – Your Grant Application:

Part A – Application Details (Continued)

Question 4:

Here you should let us know if you have been awarded funding from our legacy fund before. This is only applicable after 2023.

Question 5:

Here you should let us know if you are receiving funding from anywhere else. This is so we can ensure all guidelines are being met.

Question 6:

Here we are looking to find out the social impact you think your project will have, and the difference you will make. This will be a short-term goal (i.e. the next 6 – 12 months) that the fund and employability solutions can help you to achieve.

Question 7:

Here we are looking to see what your long-term goals are, and what difference you want to make in your life or in the lives of others. Do you have any goals for the next 2,3 or 5 years that the grant can help you start to achieve? This question is looking at your future ambitions.

Question 8:

Here we are looking for you to list all social media platforms that will be associated with your project. This will be reviewed prior to shortlisting. This may not be applicable to everyone.

Further Information:

This is where you can go into detail about your idea, who you are aiming to work with, how you are planning to work with them, what evidence you will gather, what expected outcome of the project, and what difference you are trying to make in the community and area that you live in. We would also like to know a little about your future intentions, what would you do if you received follow-up funding, is your project something that could be sustained after the 12 months? Anything that helps us to better understand your idea.



Section 3

Declaration:

This must be completed by both the applicant and a nominated person from their sponsor organisation - the nominated person should be the person we would contact should we have any further questions or require any more information.

Use of Personal Information Consent Form:

It is vital that all sections of this Consent form are signed and dated. Your application cannot be processed or considered unless all sections are completed. Please read this thoroughly before you sign. We will keep in contact with you to ensure this is completed before the decision is made.
